Requirements

- English skills (minimum B2)

Typical fields of study include agricultural sciences, animal sciences or related disciplines – but students from other relevant fields are also welcome to apply.

Typical program structure

Week 1: Onboarding

Introduction to the EW Group and its network at EW Group headquarters in Germany.

Included travel to one of the related layer distribution companies across Europe for a company specific onboarding at the respective headquarter.

Week 2-7: Practical Insights

Practical internship at the respective layer distribution company.

You will gain insights into different areas of poultry production, including:

- Parent stock management
- Production of hatching eggs
- Hatchery operations
- Rearing of commercial hens
- Farm management and production processes

Week 8: Check-out

Review and final feedback session at the practical internship layer distribution company. Travel back to EW Headquarters for program completion and networking opportunities.
